Pool Safety

The provincial Government would like to remind pool owners of the regulations put in place to protect children:

- Access to your pool must be controlled at all times (a gate that latches automatically).
- Owners that had their pool before Nov. 2010 and who benefited from an exemption, have until Sept. 30th 2025 to make their installation conform.
- The by-law applies to all pools that contain 60 cm of water or more whether in-ground, above ground or removable. Restrictions regarding diving boards also apply.
- The Municipality is responsible for applying the by-law and as such, a permit is required for the installation of a pool. www.quebec.ca/piscinesresidentielles for more information
