By-Law # 23-01 – April 12th at 6:30 PM there will be a public information meeting held at the Community Center, 55 route Gallagher. This By-Law is to adopt standards and provisions relative to the demolition of immovables as described in Articles 148.0.2 of the Land use, planning and development Act (RLRQ, c.A-19.1). Anyone with questions or concerns is invited to attend.

Guaranteed Income Supplement (65+)

The Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS) is a monthly benefit that is not taxable and income-based. It is paid to Canadian residents who receive Old Age Security benefits and have low incomes. GIS benefits are renewed automatically each July, provided that the client files an income tax return by April 30.
