Horizons Gaspésiens is a solidarity cooperative which promotes sharing of resources, supports collective projects, and fosters solidarity and mutual aid. The coop has a neat multifunctional space in the heart of Bonaventure's village called *Loco Loco*. It's open to everyone and offers dynamic and diversified programming (calendar is on website). The premises are spacious bright and colorful, and are equipped with a kitchen, internet, coworking spaces and games like ping pong. The coop supports many of its members initiatives, such as "La Page Pourpre", a feminist, queer and trans-inclusive library; "Les cafés-réparation", a friendly get togethers where everyone brings something to repair, to fight waste and planned obsolescence; "Le Partage Heure", a service exchange network which allows people to trade know-how and help based on the principle of "1 hour = 1 hour"; and "le groupe d'achat" so Horizons Gaspésiens members order food together (bulk, local, organic).
