The Department informs the public about the correct way to dispose of a bird carcass

Generally speaking, the carcasses of wild birds can be put in a bag and thrown in the garbage. Carcasses should not be touched with bare hands. The best way to do this is to wear gloves and use a lined plastic bag to pick up the carcass and then throw it away. The person should then wash their hands with soap and water or use a hydroalcoholic solution whose concentration is at least 60% alcohol.

Additional information on the protocol for safely disposing of a dead wild bird carcass is available on Québec.ca. In case of doubt, citizens can contact Service Québec at 1 877 644 4545.
