Avian Flu - Dead Birds

If you find a dead bird: do not touch the carcass with bare hands – put it in a double plastic bag and knot it – put the bag in the garbage and make sure it is inaccessible to animals – wash your hands with soap and water or a disinfectant with at least 60% alcohol.
