### **Coming into force**

By-Law #23-01 to regulate the demolition of immovables came into force on June 22<sup>nd</sup> after it's adoption by the Council on May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023. The purpose and consequences of this By-Law are to adopt the standards and dispositions relative to the demolition of immovables, as described in articles 148.0.2 etc of the land use and urbanization laws (RLRQ, c.A-19.1) The By-Law is available for consultation at the Town Hall.



# **Pool Safety**

The provincial Government would like to remind pool owners of the regulations put in place to protect children:

- Access to your pool must be controlled at all times (a gate that latches automatically).
- Owners that had their pool before Nov. 2010 and who benefited from an exemption, have until Sept. 30<sup>th</sup> 2025 to make their installation conform.
- The by-law applies to all pools that contain 60 cm of water or more whether in-ground, above ground or removable. Restrictions regarding diving boards also apply.

The Municipality is responsible for applying the by-law and as such, a permit is required for the installation of a pool. Visit <a href="www.quebec.ca/piscinesresidentielles">www.quebec.ca/piscinesresidentielles</a> for more information
