The three most common causes of avoidable fires are as follows: **cigarett butts** which account for 80 fires/year, **loss of control of an open air fire** 75 fires/year and **camp fires that are not extinguished properly** 60 fires/year. With more frequent and longer dry periods it is imperative that people develop better **habits to avoid the loss of life, property and damage to the environment.**

ROAD SAFETY

Particular care must be taken in agricultural areas. We remind you that is is forbiden to drive on the shoulder of the road for all motorized vehicles, including tractors. - A continuous double line
- A double line formed by a broken line and a solid line
